

## Extended abstract submission

Authors who wish to present their research at the conference must submit the extended abstracts according to the guidelines given below.

Length: **maximum 1000 words (additionally one figure or table can be included).**

Deadline: **March 31<sup>st</sup> (May 16<sup>th</sup> for extended), 2022.** Abstracts will be reviewed by the international steering committee & local organizing committee and feedback will be given to the authors by **May 15<sup>th</sup> (May 30<sup>th</sup> for extended) 2022.** Revised abstracts based on this review must thereafter be submitted to the conference organizer no later than **May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022 (June 10<sup>th</sup> for extended).**

Language: clear and correct English language should be used. We reserve the right to make grammatical and linguistic changes. The extended abstract will be published in the conference proceedings (electronic format) and will be available to the participants upon arrival at the conference.

Thematic session to be referred should be selected from the list that is indicated in the conference website.

Software: Save the document in MS Word format using the **First and Family name** of the presenter, for example *john.smith.doc*. Submit the document (and your figure/table) no later than **March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022 (May 16<sup>th</sup> for extended)** via *oxfordabstracts*.

By submitting your abstract, you accept that the text will be available publicly on the MMV website, and that it will be archived.

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**Recommended structure** of extended abstract includes:

- Title
- Keywords (4-5)
- Introduction and objectives
- Methodology
- Results
- Discussion & Conclusions
- Acknowledgment (in case, if it is necessary)
- References

The structure of abstract can vary from the type of research.
